Promontory Club opens clubhouse at third golf course

Overlooking Promontory Club's third golf course, its namesake clubhouse, The Hills, is now open.

The stunning building boasts a modern design and serves as a year-round amenity for golfers to hone their game with four, state-of-the-art golf simulators. Located inside the clubhouse, Sage Modern Italian offers a take on classic Italian cuisine served in an airy atmosphere with floor-to-ceiling windows featuring views of Park City and Deer Valley resorts, along with not the 18th green.

We are proud of the clubhouse’s design forward character and the wonderful job our culinary team has done to create another elevated dining concept.”

Members can work on their golf game on the four simulators named Empire Pass, Jupiter Bowl, Dreamcatcher and Olympic Park (moving south to north on the mountain range within sight). The simulators are powered by Trackman. All three Promontory golf courses will be featured through Trackman. Golf pros are available to offer small group lessons on the simulators, and two of the simulator bays are equipped with additional cameras and teaching equipment.

This summer, The Hills short course, designed by Forrest Richardson, will open for play. It features the newly constructed Golf Academy at Promontory, The GAP, which provides three more bays that open to the practice facility. One bay is dedicated to tech-based instruction, equipped with camera and Trackman teaching tools. The center “double wide” bay comprises two hitting stations for under-roof practice with a clear shot to the 300-yard range. The west bay features the TaylorMade Fitting Center at Promontory and is fully equipped with the latest Trackman technology plus TaylorMade fitting tools to provide members a custom fit for a single club or a full bag.

Sage Modern Italian restaurant is an addition to Promontory’s lineup of dining options. The open flooplan with 26-seat bar and lounge-style seating provides a gathering place while catching a game on one of three large-screen TVs. An al fresco dining patio overlooks The Hills Course’s 18th green and water feature, as well as the new 18-hole Cascade Green putting course.

Director of Food and Beverage Patrick Lowe says, “Our members have been so excited since the announcement that Promontory’s sixth restaurant would feature Italian cuisine. Together with our culinary team and consultants, we have conducted extensive research to create an authentic taste of Italy with high-quality, fresh ingredients. We love bringing our members together with delectable food and wine. The atmosphere is very conducive to socializing and enjoying a fabulous meal.”

Promontory is a 7,200-acre recreational, private mountain community with 60 percent designated open space. Promontory’s mountain setting offers year-round amenities and activities for the multi-generational family. The community consists of 1,924 total homesites with 871 homes built.
